

JOINT JEROME SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 261

RESOLUTION CALLING FOR BOARD OF TRUSTEE ELECTION

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 33-503, Idaho Code, as amended, the Board of Trustees of Joint Jerome School District No. 261 shall cause to be conducted its Annual Trustee Election on the 1st Tuesday in November for the purpose of electing Trustees for Trustee Zone 3, and Trustee Zone 4, and Trustee Zone 5.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of Jerome Joint School District No. 261, Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding Counties, Idaho as follows:

Section 1. That a trustee election be held and the same is hereby called to be held in Joint Jerome School District No. 261, Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding Counties, Idaho, on November 5, 2019, for the purpose of electing a Trustee for Zone 3, and a Trustee for Zone 4, and a Trustee for Zone 5.

Section 2. That Notice of Election shall be delivered by the Clerk of Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding County(ies), Idaho, who will cause same to be posted and published pursuant to section 34-1406, Idaho Code.

Section 3. That the polling places of said election shall be precinct poll sites determined by the Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding County Elections offices and that on November 5, 2019, the polls shall be opened between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Absentee voting shall be permitted as provided by Idaho Code Title 34.

Section 4. That said election shall be conducted by the Clerk of Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding County(ies), Idaho, pursuant to the Uniform District Election Law contained in Chapter 14, Title 34, Idaho Code.

Section 5: That no person shall vote at such trustee election who is not at the same time of election:
1. A United States Citizen, a qualified elector of the district for at least 30 days preceding the day of election, a registered voter in the district, and 18 year of age or older, within the meaning of Article 6, Section 2 of the Idaho Constitution; and
2. A bona fide resident thereof.

Section 6: That voting at said election shall be by secret and separate ballot, and shall be in substantially the following form:

Section 7. That the Clerk of the Board of Trustees shall provide to the Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding Counties Elections Office the Notice of Election as follows for publishing per Idaho Code.

NOTICE OF TRUSTEE ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the School Board Election for School District No. 261, Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding Counties, State of Idaho, will be held on November 5, 2019. The purpose of said election shall be to elect one Trustee for Zone No 3, who resides within Trustee Zone No. 3; and one Trustee for Zone No. 4, who resides within Trustee Zone No. 4; and one Trustee for Zone No. 5, who resides within Trustee Zone No. 5. Each to serve for a period of four years from the date of said election. Only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 3 may vote for a Zone No. 3 candidate; and only those only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 4 may vote for Zone No. 4 candidate; and only those only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 5 may vote for Zone No. 5 candidate.

The description of **Zone 3** is generally: A tract of land situated in the Jerome School District No. 261, Jerome County, Idaho, described as follows: BEGINNING at the intersection of Lincoln Street and 8th Avenue in the City of Jerome; Thence easterly along 8th Avenue to Fillmore Street; Thence southerly along Fillmore Street to Main Street (State Highway 25); Thence easterly along Main Street (State Highway 25) to Tiger Drive; Thence southerly along tiger Drive, 100 East and 300 South to Golf Course Road; Thence northerly along Golf Course Road and Lincoln Avenue to Avenue G; Thence Westerly along Avenue G to Birch Street; Thence northerly along Birch Street to Main Street (State highway 25); Thence easterly along Main Street (State highway 25) to Lincoln Street; Thence northerly along Lincoln Street to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The description of **Zone 4** is generally: A tract of land situated in the Jerome School District No. 261, Jerome County, Idaho, described as follows: BEGINNING at the intersection of North Road and the north district boundary; Thence easterly along the district boundary to US Highway 93; Thence southerly along US Highway 93 to State Highway 25; Thence westerly along State Highway 25 to 200 East; Thence northerly along 200 East to 50 North; Thence southwesterly and westerly along 50 North and 8th Avenue to Lincoln Avenue; Thence northerly along Lincoln Avenue and North Road to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The description of **Zone 5** is generally: A tract of land situated in the Jerome School District No. 261, Jerome County and Lincoln County, Idaho, described as follows: BEGINNING at the intersection of US Highway 93 and the north district boundary; Thence Easterly and southerly along the district boundary; Thence Easterly and northerly along the district boundary; Thence easterly and southerly along the district boundary; Thence westerly and southerly along the district boundary to the southerly district boundary Snake River; Thence along the south district boundary and the Snake River to Auger Falls Road; Thence northerly along Auger Falls Road, Yingst Road and Golf Course Road to 300 South; Thence easterly along 300 South to 100 East; Thence northerly along 100 East and Tiger Drive to Main Street (State Highway 25); Thence westerly along Main Street (State Highway 25) to Fillmore Street; Thence northerly along Fillmore Street to 8th Avenue; Thence easterly and northeasterly along 8th Avenue and 50 North to 200 East; Thence southerly along 200 East to State Highway 25; Thence easterly along State Highway 25 to US Highway 93; Thence northerly along US Highway 93 to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Section 8: That immediately following the close of the polls, the election officials so designated by the Clerk of Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding County(ies) shall tabulate the results of the election, and the Board of County Commissioners shall conduct the canvass of the election results in the manner provided in Chapter 12, Title 34, Idaho Code. The Clerk of Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding County(ies) shall certify the election results to the Clerk of Jerome Joint School District No. 261, and the district shall issue the appropriate certificate of election.

Section 9: Nominations of Candidacy forms are available at the office of the Clerk of the Board, 125 4th Avenue West, Jerome, Idaho. Nominations must be filed with the Clerk of the Board not later than 5:00 pm on September 6, 2019. As provided by Idaho code Section 33-502A no write-in vote shall be counted unless a declaration of intent has been filed with the District Clerk indicating that the person desires the office and is legally qualified to assume the duties of school trustee if elected. The deadline for filing a declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate is September 20, 2019.

Section 10: The Clerk of Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding County(ies) shall cause notice of election to be posted for at least ten (10) days prior to the date of said election in at least two (2) public places within the district, one (1) of which shall be at or near the main floor of the Administration office of said district in Jerome, Idaho.

Section 11: The Clerk of Jerome, Lincoln and Gooding County(ies) shall also cause the notice of election to be published for at least two (2) times, the first (1st) not less than twelve (12) days before the election date, and the second (2nd) not less than five (5) days before the election in a newspaper published in Jerome, Idaho, and of general circulation in said school district.

Section 12: The resolution shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and approval.
